- Organise and enhance photos

## Privacy and Security

- Much processing happens on your Mac.
- For more complex requests, Apple uses its own secure servers.
- ChatGPT integration is optional and only used with your consent\*.
- Your personal and work data should never be entered into any Apple Intelligence chat unless necessary and appropriate.
- > Student data should never be uploaded into any Apple Intelligence chat

## **University Guidance**

- 1. Try it out You can enable it in System Settings > Apple Intelligence & Siri.
- 2. **Check results** Al output can be wrong or incomplete. Always review.
- 3. **Protect data** Don't share confidential university or personal information.
- 4. **Opt out anytime** You can disable Apple Intelligence if you choose.
