How to enable automated live captioning in Google Chrome

To Enable Live Captions for Video and Audio in Google Chrome.

Please Note: You will **not** be able to see your own captions when speaking, only the participant will be able to see the captions.

- 1. Open the Google Chrome browser
- 2. Type the following text in the address bar: chrome://flags
