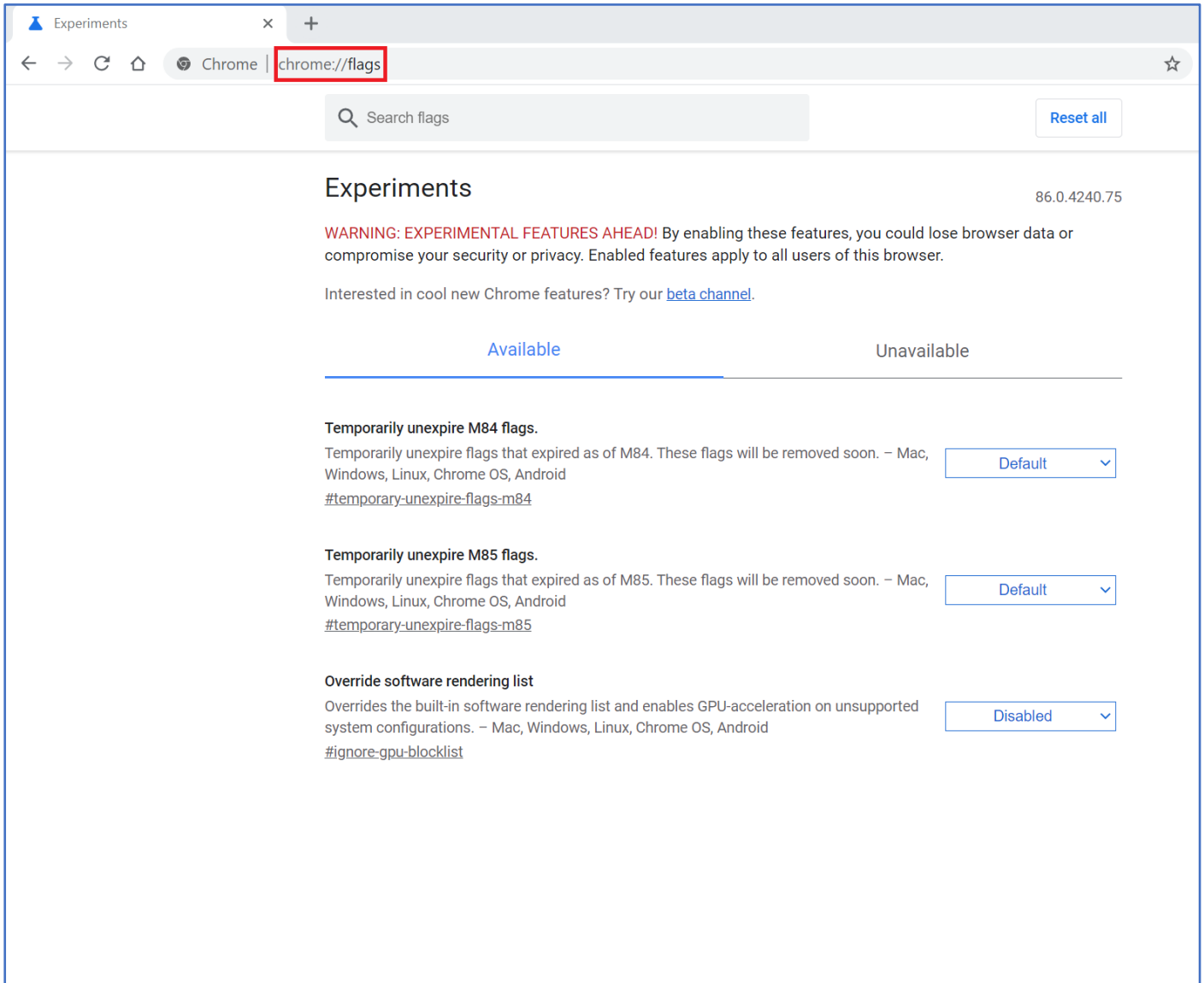


How to enable automated live captioning in Google Chrome

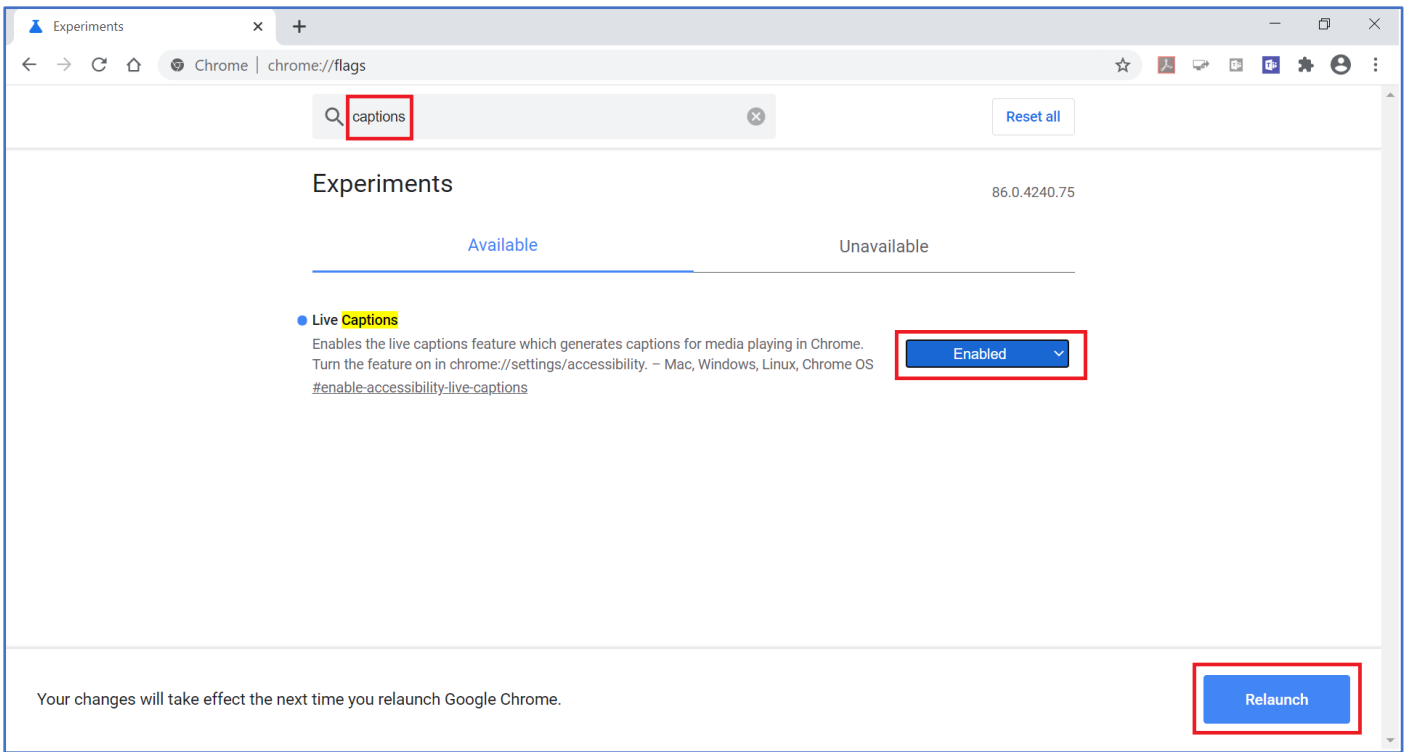
To Enable Live Captions for Video and Audio in Google Chrome.

Please Note: You will **not** be able to see your own captions when speaking, only the participant will be able to see the captions.

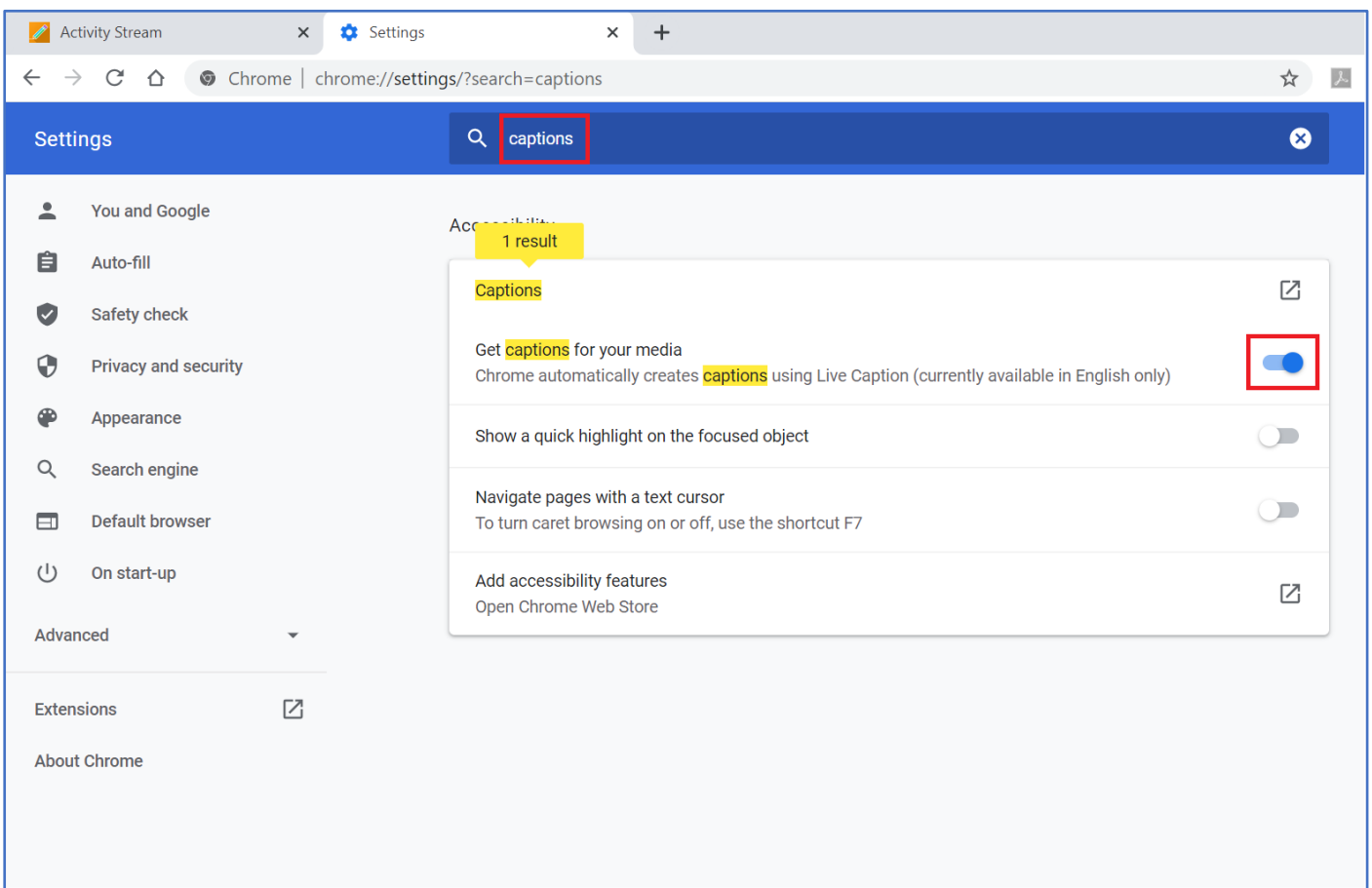
1. Open the Google **Chrome browser**
2. Type the following text in the address bar: **chrome://flags**



3. Next, type the following text in the Search flags text box: **captions**
4. Select *Enabled* from the drop-down list next to the *Live Captions* option
5. **Relaunch** the browser when prompted



6. Open the menu (Alt+F), select Settings, and type the following text in the Search settings text box: **captions**
7. Select the switch to enable the live captions feature



8. To test that this feature is working, you can load a Collaborate recording, click on play, and then the live captions should appear at the bottom of the browser in a caption box. *Please note that this feature also works for live sessions, in the same way.*

If for any reason the caption box disappears, please refresh (F5) the Chrome Browser
